

DUBLIN CITY COUNCIL UPDATES

Actions Taken by the Dublin City Council

February 2nd

- 12 community members were appointed to the City's Green Initiatives Task Force
- The City Council decided to ride together in a float for the St. Patrick's Day Parade
- A presentation was given on the results of the recently conducted community survey. The survey showed broad resident support for the City, with 86% rating Dublin's quality of life as very good or excellent and 79% expressing specifically that the City's services were very good or excellent. The Council agreed to continue with ongoing community engagement as a component of its Communications Initiative
- The City Council received its Comprehensive Annual Financial Audit Report for 2008-2009 Fiscal year. The report commended the City for its excellent fiscal management and oversight.
- Dublin receives over \$81,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from Alameda County, and the Council used the money to fund 10 non-profit organizations and agencies
- The City Council voted to officially support the "Biosolids to Energy Coaliton"
