Take Wheels to the Alameda County Fair! *We'll get you there!*

Livermore, CA --- June 9, 2010 --- Fairgoers gearing up for their yearly dose of carnival rides, games and food can save money and avoid traffic snarls by taking Wheels Route 10 to the Alameda County Fair, **June 23 – July 11, 2010**.

Fairgoers coming in on BART can board a regularly-scheduled Route 10 bus on the Pleasanton side of the Dublin/Pleasanton BART Station which provides convenient and frequent service to Downtown Pleasanton. Exit the bus at the corner of Peters/Rose Avenue and follow the signs to the Fair's East Gate entrance on Pleasanton Avenue, approximately 2 blocks west from the bus stop. Livermore residents can also leave their cars at home and catch the bus to go to the fair. Fairgoers can board any Route 10 bus along Railroad Avenue or board at the Wheels Transit Center located at 2500 Railroad Avenue in Downtown Livermore. Ample free parking is available on the third level at the Livermore Valley Center Parking Garage adjacent to the Transit Center.

“Welcome to the 2010 Alameda County Fair. We appreciate the opportunity to get you and your family to the festivities” said Jerry Thorne, this year's Chair of the Livermore Amador Valley Transit Authority. “Taking the bus to the fair is an affordable option to rising fuel costs and is a fun way for families to begin and end their day together.”

The regular adult/student cash fare is \$2.00 (one-way trip), seniors (age 65 and over) are \$1.00 and Disabled Citizens is \$1.00 (one-way trip) with a valid RTC Discount Card. Children under 6 years of age ride free with a paying adult.
